

Nature Journaling: Interview an Organism

Find an organism to interview. (Organisms in videos work too.) Ask it questions you can answer through observation. Take notes with words, pictures, and numbers.

Types of Questions to Ask:

<p><u>Descriptive</u> structures of its body, colors, habitat and surroundings, etc.</p>	<p><u>Counting and Measurement</u> how tall, how many limbs, how many of this kind of organism, etc.</p>	<p><u>Behavior</u> what it is doing, how it reacts to you getting closer, how it interacts with other organisms, etc.</p>	<p><u>Time</u> how long it does a behavior, how long between repeated behaviors, etc.</p>
