1	Find an interesting object. Ask 3 questions about it.	Find two different leaves or flowers. Draw and/or write to show what is the same and what is different about them.	Play animal charades: Imitate an animal and have someone guess what it is.	Find two rocks. Try making rock paint: Get one rock wet and rub the rocks together. If your rocks work for making paint, you can use it as face paint or on paper. Try different rocks to make better paint or to get different colors.	Find an interesting object. Say 2 things it reminds you of.
2	Tell someone something you are grateful for.	Find a tree or a picture of a tree. Make up a yoga pose that represents the shape of the tree.	Listen for a sound made by an animal. Do your best imitation.	Find an interesting object. Describe how it smells.	Make a rubbing: Find a textured surface, like a leaf, tree bark, or a sidewalk. Put a piece of paper over it. Rub all across the paper with crayons, colored pencils, or a regular pencil.
3	Drink some water.	Look closely at your fingerprints. What patterns do you notice? Can you find patterns like that somewhere else in nature?	Take a deep breath.	Spend 5 minutes looking at the sky – or lie under a tree and look up.	Find an interesting object. Describe how it feels.
4	Watch the sunrise or sunset.	Sit in one spot for 5 minutes and count how many living things you can see.	Find an interesting object. Describe how it looks.	Write a poem about a part of nature.	Try to walk as silently as you can.
5	Find an interesting object. Describe how it sounds.	Look at some clouds (outside or in a photo). Tell someone what you think they look like.	Try to find at least 5 different colors outside. Can you find the colors in objects not made by humans?	Find a bug. Observe it for 3 minutes.	Find an interesting piece of nature. Draw a picture of it. (suggestions: part of a plant, an animal, your foot, something in the sky)
